

Instructions to reply to the IRS letter on missing Form 8962

- 1) Open your return.
- 2) Go to File (upper left hand corner), scroll down and select Save As.




- 3) Save your return with a new name such as "original return with 8962" and click **Save**.
- 4) Go to Federal Taxes tab (if using the Home and Business Product, go to the Personal tab) and then select the Health Insurance tab.




5) Answer the question on the *Did you (both) have health insurance coverage in 2016?* screen and then click **Continue**.




- 6) On the next few screens, you'll answer health insurance questions and also enter the information from your **Form 1095-A**.
- 7) The *That's all we need to continue your 2016 coverage* screen will be the last Health Insurance screen. Click **Continue**.



8) Now you are ready to print your Form 8962 to send to the IRS. Select the **FILE** tab and then **Print/Save for Your Records**.



9) On the *Print and save Your Tax Return* screen, click **Print** to print the form you need.



10) In the *Form Selection* window, select **Specific Forms** and then check the box for **Form 8962**. Finally, select **Preview Print Copy** and then print the form.
