Before you begin

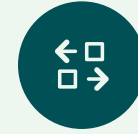
Here are a few points to help orient you to this guide.



Soon, your firm will be moving from QuickBooks Online Accountant (QBOA) to the more powerful Intuit Accountant Suite. Switching platforms is technically simple. And, we'll help you with the coordination, communication, and confidence you'll need to lead your firm through the transition.



This deck is for Primary admins responsible for toggling from QuickBooks Online Accountant to Intuit Accountant Suite and rallying a team around the change.



Use this deck to seamlessly move to Intuit Accountant Suite and/or you're responsible for rolling this out across your firm.

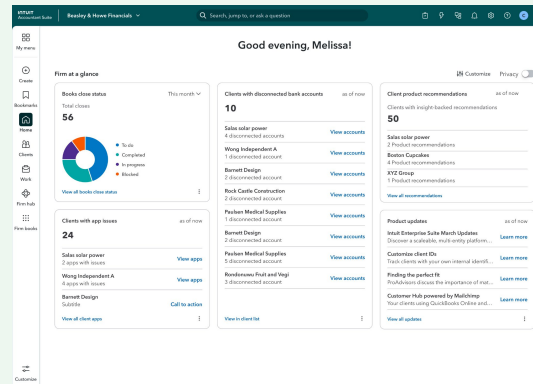
Switching to Intuit Accountant Suite Core is simple and free

Making the switch is as easy as visiting QuickBooks Online Accountant and toggling to the updated platform—no complex migration necessary.

- Firms with multiple QuickBooks Online Accountant consoles can switch them all to Intuit Accountant Suite. Consolidating consoles is not required.
- All client data will transfer automatically, including existing user roles and access permissions.
- Since only Primary admins can initiate the switch, be sure to pass this guide to them. That way, your firm can best follow this change management plan and coordinate a smooth rollout.

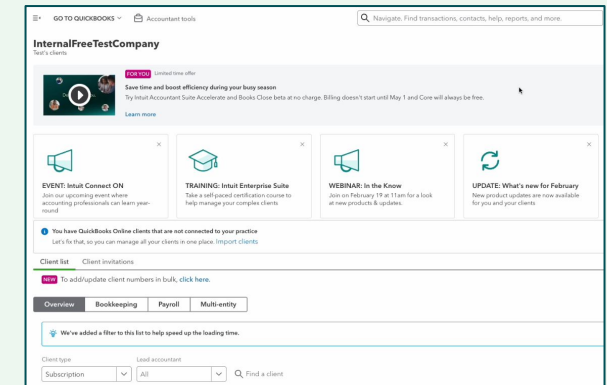

Step 1: Assembling your crew

Set your team up for success with 1-2 designated leads.



Project lead/champion

This is you, the overall owner of the transition, responsible for tracking the timeline and the relationship with Intuit.

Key responsibilities

- Establishes a clear path for team questions (e.g., a specific person, email address, or submission form)
- Acts as the designated “power user” and go-to resource, so the whole team can easily preview Intuit Accountant Suite



Communications lead

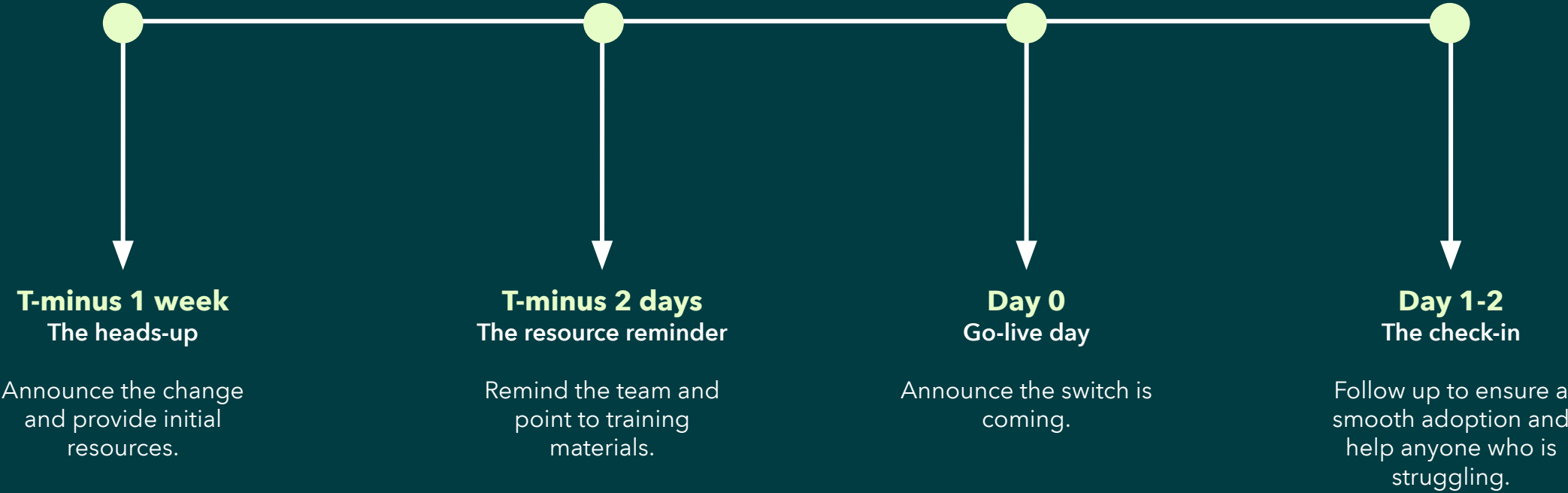
This is the voice of the transition, ensuring everyone has the right info at the right time. (This may be the same person as the Project Lead.)

Key responsibilities

- Sends all pre-launch, go-live, and post-launch emails
- Manages related announcements through additional channels like Slack or Microsoft Teams

Step 2: Prepping your communication plan

Here's an overview of how you'll share go-live updates with your firm.



Step 3: Completing your communication plan

Effective communication is critical. This section contains ready-to-send email templates for each phase of your rollout. Each template includes the strategic goal, timing, and customizable text.

The announcement email

Goal: Send a “heads up” message to create excitement and reassure staff that their workflow won’t break.

Send date: T-minus 1 week
