### What is the Social Innovation Challenge?

Intuit's Social Innovation Challenge engages students from school districts and educational organizations across North America to leverage design thinking as they develop innovative solutions to solve a problem prompt. Students compete in teams to win prizes from swag to scholarships.



## What problem will my team be solving?

Participating teams will be tasked with helping to make their school more sustainable. First, you'll identify what problem you are solving and who you're solving it for. Are you solving for students, teachers, or another target audience? Maybe you'll decide to focus on helping teachers create sustainable classrooms, or perhaps you'll want to encourage fellow students to recycle. Once you decide on your team's focus, you'll learn the Design for Delight methodology and use what you've learned to solve your challenge!



#### What is the time commitment?

Your time commitment for the Social Innovation Challenge may vary, depending on your level of effort and the requirements of your project. We estimate that the project should take teams about 15-20 hours to complete. Here's a breakdown:

- Reviewing the challenge materials (Guidebook, Deliverables & Rubric, YouTube Videos, etc.): 1-2 hours
- Design for Delight course: 4-6 hours
- Customer interviews: 2-3 hours
- Developing the project/solution: 4-5 hours
- Presentation prep: 1-2 hours



# Did you say "prize money?"

Yes! Finalist winners will receive prize money awards that they can use for future educational needs, such as tuition, books, technology, or even continuing your team's project.
